Equine Canada Statement of Principles

Equine Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

EC is committed to:

- Upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- Requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment
- Ensuring that owners, trainers and exhibitors or their agents use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose
- Providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition official to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, sanitation and safety as a matter of standard operating procedure;
- Continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- Increasing education in training and horsemanship practices;
- Requiring owners, trainers and exhibitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition;
- Reviewing, revising and developing competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of horses.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person, informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and exhibition procedures, would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

RULES:

1. All Equine Canada Rules and Regulations apply to this show. It is the responsibility of Exhibitors and Visitors to familiarize themselves with these rules. The 2010 EC Rule Book can now be downloaded at www.equinecanada.ca
2. All protests will follow the EC Rule Book.
3. Horse licenses are not required. Amateur card number is required.
4. All riders must wear proper fitting, approved protective headgear, with the safety harness correctly secured, at all times while mounted on the event grounds. Approved headgear meets ASTM standards and displays the SEI seal. The British standard, BSI, is also acceptable.
5. Any class may be cancelled if insufficient entries.
6. Each horse/rider combination will be assigned their own individual number. The correct number must be worn in the class to be eligible for points and prizes. Competition numbers must be worn and visible at all times in the schooling and exercise areas as well as in the competition ring.
7. It is a condition of entry that Red River, North Hill & Quarry Ridge Pony Clubs and its volunteers and employees will not be responsible for the loss of tack and/or equipment, and/or injury to horse and/or rider. Waiver form must be signed by competitor and/or guardian of junior rider in order to be eligible to compete or ride on show grounds.
8. All exhibitors and riders must have a 2010 Manitoba Horse Council membership to confirm insurance coverage. This membership number must be shown on the entry form.
9. Hunter divisions will offer back to back (classes/rounds) ... riders must ride their first class first and their second class second.
10. **CANCELLATION OF ENTRIES:** Competitors cancelling their entries after the official closing date and before the first class of the show who provide a certificate of disability from a veterinarian, will **forfeit the office and stall fees (if stall not re-assigned)**. Competitors cancelling their entries after the start of the show, will receive no refunds at the discretion of show committee.
11. Any horse entered in any class at this competition may, while on the competition grounds be selected for equine medication control testing.
12. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times.

Entries MUST BE IN THE HANDS OF THE SHOW SECRETARY 10 pm, Friday, May 14th, 2010 (POSTMARKED NO LATER THAN May 11th). A \$20 surcharge will added to late or incomplete entries. Late entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis, stabling permitted. A \$25 surcharge will be charged for all N.S.F. cheques. No post-dated cheques will be accepted.

SHOW GROUNDS OPEN SATURDAY 8:00 AM – stabling will not be allowed any earlier than this time. Overnite camping in assigned areas only ... no electrical sites available in the barn area. HORSE TRAILER parking in designated areas only. Stabling is limited and will be assigned on a 1st entered basis. Enter early to insure a stall.

CHAMPIONSHIP & RESERVE CHAMPIONSHIP RIBBONS TO ALL HUNTER DIVISIONS & THE HACK DIVISION. (IN THE CASE OF A TIE IN THE HUNTER DIVISION, THE PLACEMENTS IN THE STAKES CLASS WILL DECIDE THE CHAMPIONSHIP. IN EQUITATION DIVISIONS, THE PLACEMENT IN THE OVER FENCES CLASS WILL BE DECISIVE FOR THE AWARD.)

HIGH POINT PONY CLUB COOLERS will be based on the total of the following points:

2 jumping rounds (Hunter classes in one division **or** Jumper classes in one division **or** Pony Club Cross Rails & Pony Club Equitation Over Cross Rails) 1 Equitation Hunt Seat on the Flat Class and 1 Dressage Score (ties will be broken by points earned from Dressage Test).

Only one dressage award and one high point cooler per competitor, please. Anyone winning more than one will be asked to choose one and the other(s) will be awarded to the reserve rider(s). In the case of a tie, the placement in the stakes class will decide the high point award.

NOTE: All classes/divisions offered are not rated for EC awards except for the Combined Pony Hunter Division and Children's Hunter Division. In these Divisions horses/ponies must be jogged for soundness (see Article G406.2) Juniors showing any horse in a jog for soundness must wear approved protective headgear with attached safety harness fastened.

THIS DOCUMENT WILL AFFECT YOUR LEGAL RIGHTS AND LIABILITIES.
PLEASE READ CAREFULLY.

- 1) I acknowledge that any activity involving horses is high risk including but not limited to:
 - (a) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bite or kick other animals, people or objects;
 - (b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
 - (c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities to maintain control over an equine.
