

# Teaching Subjects for Camp 2010

1. Safety around horses. Some common sense do's and don'ts  
Leading, managing horses alone and in groups.
2. Pasture and its management, fencing, shelter and water requirements  
Feed and feeding: grain, hay and water requirements
3. Grooming: including show grooming, bathing and braiding  
Tacking up: English, Western. Care and cleaning of tack
4. Stables, barns and stalls, design, water, fittings, bedding, mucking out
5. Blankets: requirements, putting on and taking off  
Wrapping: legs for exercise, legs for travel, legs for stable, tail
6. First aid and when to call the vet. Keeping your horse healthy.  
The foot, trimming and shoeing
7. Trailering: preparation to travel, loading, driving and unloading  
Attire: what's correct, what's not. Show ring attire
8. Braiding and show preparation
