

# MISTY RIVER SHOW TEAM - 2010

## SHOW CHECKLIST

### RIDING APPAREL

- Helmet
- Hair nets or black or navy blue scrunchie for braid if under 12 years of age
- Show jacket
- Show shirt(s) with collar(s) Must be white for dressage and have sleeves (long or short), other pastel colours allowed for hunters and jumpers
- Stock pin
- Stock tie for dressage (optional but must have stock pin to complete) plus two safety or nappy pins to secure flappy ends
- Breeches: beige or off white or white for dressage
- Belt
- Boot socks
- Talcum powder (for tight boots)
- Boot pulls (to get tight boots on)
- Boot jack (to get tight boots off!)
- Leather boots or
- ½ chaps & paddock boots if your discipline allows them. Black only.
- Gloves: black or white, see discipline rules
- Whip: jumping or dressage or both for eventers
- Spurs: if used
- Jacket cover or some type of plastic cover to keep off dust

### TACK

- Saddle with stirrups & leathers with cover. CLEAN
- Bridle with bit & reins. CLEAN
- Bridle number discs
- Martingale with attachments, if needed
- Girth(s)
- Saddle pads (exercise quality for warm ups & show quality for actually competing in)
- Half pad (if used)
- Wraps &/or boots &/or bell boots
- Extra bits, spare reins/bridle in case of disasters
- Bridle bag, saddle bag &/or cover
- Check all stitching on your tack at least a week before the show. If suspect, replace with new.
- All tack must be thoroughly cleaned before being packed

### BRAIDING/PLAITING KIT

- Gel, hairspray or Quickbraid
- Clips (for holding mane out of the way)
- Yarn or elastics or thread
- Mane comb
- Step stool
- Pull through or needles
- Scissors
- Braiding apron

## SHOW CHECKLIST

### TRAVEL GEAR

- Travel Rug: appropriate to the season. Preferably a navy blue cotton sheet or fleece, NO purples/pinks etc. These are fine for home here, but not for travel away.
- Shipping boots/wraps. Navy with white pillows or cottons underneath
- Leather halter (with or without fuzzies) with lead rope or leather shank with chain
- Tail bandage or tail guard. Navy or black

### HORSE OVERNIGHT GEAR

- Standing wraps & cottons. Navy or black
- Extra rugs (cotton sheet, cooler, winter rug, fly sheet) Navy.

### WASH DOWN KIT

- Nylon halter (so your fuzzies don't get saturated in the bathroom/washdown)
- Bucket
- Shampoo
- Conditioner
- Sponges, rags/towels
- Sweat scraper

### LEATHER CLEANING KIT

- Small bucket
- Saddle soap
- Saddle conditioner
- Sponges, rags
- Boot polish and brushes

### GROOMING GEAR

- Grooming kit with brushes, pick etc.
- Extra lead rope
- Show sheen
- Hoof polish or oil
- Quarter markers
- Clippers or disposable razors for trimming horse facial/chin hair
- Fly repellent, horse and human

### FIRST AID KIT

- wound cleaner
- cotton wool balls
- Nitro- furacine
- Vaseline or other mild antiseptic topical application
- Green cool or other suitable leg brace
- Ice tight poultice
- vet wraps
- Human band aids

## SHOW CHECKLIST

YOUR PERSONAL BUCKET OF LOVE (to go ringside with you and your horse, carried by Mum, Dad or helper)

This bucket or bag should be named.

- Show sheen
- Boot polish with rag
- Bottle(s) of water
- Marker/pen (to write on your ribbons)
- Show schedule or order of go
- Copy of dressage test preferably laminated
- Body brush
- Fly spray
- Towel
- Wet sponge in plastic bag (for horses nose and mouth)
- Kleenex (as above, but for rider)
- Safety pins, threaded needle and thread.

### FEED ITEMS

- 3 buckets with clips (one for feed, two for water) plus bailing twine or bucket hangers. NOT your usual stall ones from Misty. They remain here.
- Hay
- Hay net
- Grain
- Grain scoops
- Oil, RED CELL, electrolytes or any other supplements placed in small containers and with horses name on it.
- Feed list of who gets what feed and when
- Carrots, apples, treats

### STABLE EQUIPMENT

- Hook over or free standing saddle rack
- Hook over bridle hooks
- Extra sets of hooks
- Stall guard
- Stall name plate with horse and riders name, coach's name, emergency telephone numbers, laminated.
- Shovels, brooms, pitchforks, muck forks
- Muck skip
- Wheel barrow, sack truck
- Extra bailing twine
- Misty River stall curtains
- Medical Record Forms (rider)
- Hose (the above 8 items: per barn, not per horse, but do not ignore, they have to be packed.)
- SARAH'S GOLF CART!!

### **SHOW CHECKLIST**

- The “Box of Lurve” This is the Misty Show Team’s essential show survival kit. From safety pins to the tack stall padlock, from spare hairnets to spare hay nets, its all in there.

#### PERSONAL ITEMS

- Show schedule/prizelist
- Copy of completed entry form and proof of payment.
- Membership cards
- Passport (horse) if competing at Gold level show. Not required for bronze or silver level shows.
- Coggins test results. Only required for out of Province shows.
- Horse Health Papers: only required when competing in the States.
- Chairs
- Cameras
- Cell phone
- Money \$\$
- Extra change of clothes
- Rain jackets, rubber boots, winter jackets, hats etc.
- Sunscreen
- Water & food for self
- If overnighiting at show: sleeping bags, camp bed, pillow, food, alarm clock.
