

## Summer Camps at Misty River

The daily camp routine will include riding, grooming, theory classes and lots of hands on horse and stable care. We also swim, play volleyball, go bird and nature watching, (sometimes on horseback) and paint souvenir horseshoes. You will also be able to meet all this year's new foals. All standards of riders are welcome and will be grouped according to age and experience. Riding groups will have a maximum of eight pupils to one instructor. Each coach or instructor has assistants with her to help the campers. You will be riding a minimum of once a day with riding periods of approximately an hour and a half duration but the trail ride may be longer.

A selection of subjects that may be covered:
Learning how to look after your horse, grooming and tacking up Having fun with gymkhana games
Going trail riding safely
Grooming for the show ring including braiding
Learn about tack preparation and correct show attire
Veterinary and hoof care
Jumping a course, both hunter fences and jumper fences
Learning to lunge and how to use a round pen
Observing starting a young horse under saddle
Dressage and show jumping demonstrations

All riding and horse care sessions will be tailored to suit the experience of the campers, whether experienced or beginners and the age of the campers. Camp hours are: 9am till 4pm but you may drop off at 8am and pick up at 5pm if you wish at no extra cost.

The cost for a week will be: \$330 including all taxes. Places can be secured by payment in full. Refund policy: cancellation 28 days prior to first day of camp: 90% refund. Cancellation 14 days prior to first day of camp: 50% refund. Cancellation 7 days or less prior to first day of camp: no refund.

You will need to bring with you: a packed lunch, swimming things, wet weather gear (just in case), riding helmet if you have one, if not, we can supply, boots or stout shoes to ride in, and a change of clothes if you decide to participate in the water fight! Our camps are full on, friendly, educational, exhausting, rewarding and HUGE FUN! Be prepared to get filthy, play games, make some new friends, (both human and equine), run around a lot, brush a lot, ride a lot and learn a lot. We can't wait!
