WELCOME TO THE ENGLISH RIDING ACADEMY AT MISTY RIVER RANCH

THE LESSON PROGRAM. Thank you for your enquiry about riding lessons at Misty River. We run a full lesson program catering for students of all ages and riding abilities. We teach the English style of riding from complete beginners through to seasoned competitive riders. For more advanced riders, the disciplines of hunter, jumper and dressage are also taught. Lessons are available in both groups or in a private or semi private format. In a group lesson the usual number of students is four but occasionally we will go to the maximum number of students, which is six. Lessons last for a full hour.

THE GROUPS. Students are grouped according to age and ability. Lessons take place in the evenings, and at weekends. Day camps are offered during holidays.

THE HORSES. We have a fine selection of school horses ranging from small ponies to large thoroughbreds and warmbloods. They are all safe, well schooled and very experienced in their job of teaching people to ride. Don't forget though, that a horse is an animal, and therefore riding cannot be guaranteed to be 100% safe. Having said that, our coaches are all very experienced, and will never put you in harms way or force you to do something you are not comfortable with.

EQUIPMENT. To begin with you do not need any specialist equipment. Helmets are compulsory and if you do not have your own, they can be borrowed from us. Runners or trainers are not suitable footwear, a boot or shoe with a small heel and smooth sole are ideal. Long socks under long pants will help prevent legs from being rubbed. Shorts are not suitable. In winter, warmth is the key, so lots of layers and ski pants are just fine. Gloves are essential. COST. Private lessons are \$65 each, semi privates: \$50 each and group lessons are \$225 for a set of five or \$45 each. These prices include GST. We require five weeks notice when ceasing or pulling out of the lesson program. The minimum commitment is 10 weeks. We look forward to helping you to start or progress in your riding career.

FROM WINNIPEG:

Take Lagimodiere BLVD (or highway 59) South. Keep heading south and cross over the perimeter highway, cross over the floodway and take your first turning to your left, which is south side road.
